TAMARIND HALL broke on top, had the rider cast a couple of glances to the inside, saw CURLINA advancing along the rail, was grabbed hold and eased back, stalked the pacesetter under a good hold from the two path, made what proved to be a decisive move, bursting through a narrow opening between the front runners to take charge at the quarter pole, was set down to a hard drive, drew out to a sizeable advantage during the ensuing furlong and held sway. KID KATE unhurried for nearly a half, swung three wide into the stretch and was up for the place. SPA CITY PRINCESS urged early, rallied for the show. CHRISTINE DAAE took the overland route and had no rally. CURLINA advanced on her own power to grab the front soon after the start, showed the way from the inside, with HILDA'S PASSION, the closest pursuer, but from the three path, got overtaken by the winner's strong and sudden challenge nearing the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. HILDA'S PASSION pressed the pacesetter three wide and folded. COMIC MARVEL four wide at the half mile pole, was through after completing a half.
