Footnotes

DIXIE SPARKLE quickly established control, cut the pace firmly rated and kept at a slight distance from off the rail, got let out for the stretch and remained sufficiently in the clear. DIAMOND MAKER gave chase three to four wide on the turn, lacked the needed response. MINI MUFFIN darted over to the rail after the start, pulled on the bit for a portion of the way down the backstretch, advanced steadily towards the winner as the tempo slowed down, was forced to remain on hold nearing the quarter pole, lacking optimal room to launch a rail bid, angled outward into the two path for the commencement of the stretch run, got outfinished. ADIRONDACK SKY guided over to the rail coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was no factor. VAID gave chase from the outside for nearly a half, drifted outward while giving way through the furlong grounds and was eased. YACANTMAKETHISUP took an awkward first step inward, trailed throughout and got eased entering the stretch.
