Footnotes

CAPE COD CAROL broke slightly to the outside, with the rider of the second place finisher grabbing a hold and shying away as a result, settled into the two path during the initial stages, was under a snug hold stalking the front runners, sat wedged in between rivals for a good portion of the run around the bend, saw some room to maneuver outward prior to the quarter pole and slipped into the three path, was given her cue spinning into the stretch, outfought another pair making her way through the furlong grounds to take over, dug in well enough to hold on. LITTLE ROCKET taken hold to avoid any possible contact with the winner at the start, got away a beat slowly, raced from off the inside, was asked for run turning for home, responded positively, altered course a couple of paths to be outside the top one with a furlong remaining, closed in with good belated energy but fell short. LENDERS WAY pressed the issue being two wide, had CAPE COD CAROL made it a three-way fight for command as the field headed into the stretch, vied from between rivals from that point until a few strides past the eighth pole before backing away a bit. DIVADORA went at it one on one with FIFTYFOUR FOREVER along the backstretch, shook that rival off and tucked along the rail at the half mile pole, was under a firm hold while vying with LENDERS WAY parked to the outside for the next quarter, tuned for home and was let out as a dispute involving the previously-mentioned foe and the winner commenced, failed to keep pace and weakened. SPA CITY LOVER mostly three wide on the turn, folded. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER argued for command from along the inside early, got shaken off, kept pace on the turn, needing encouragement to do so, retreated after entering the stretch then was pulled up quickly after crossing the finish line.
