Footnotes

HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS just off the pace just off the inside, got set down angled three to four wide into upper stretch, rallied outside a trio a furlong out, took command nearing the sixteenth pole and inched away in the late stages to prevail. DOCTOR DOSS bumped at the start when BOBBY FLAY broke out and in turn bumped IRISH LION, tracked the pace along the inside, got set down at the quarter pole swinging just off the inside, rallied to take command amongst a quartet just past the eighth pole, got displaced soon after, dug in with good energy for the place. INDY SEA three wide within range, got set down at the head of the stretch, rallied outside a pair to the eighth pole, got joined outside by the eventual winner, kicked on with good energy but was out kicked in the late stages. IRISH LION bumped at the start by DOCTOR DOSS due to pressure from BOBBY FLAY, settled three to four wide in mid pack, got let out angled five wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. SLAMARAMA on the pace in hand from the three path initially, gradually made his way to the fence three furlongs out, got set down cutting the corner into the stretch, dug in under challenge by a pair to the eighth pole, got headed just inside that station and weakened to the wire. SKY BLUE PINK broke out at the start and was corrected, got outrun early on settling three to four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung six wide for home and passed tired foes in the stretch. SLAN ABHAILE two to three wide towards the rear, got asked swinging four wide for home and offered no serious response. BOBBY FLAY broke out at the start bumping DOCTOR DOSS into IRISH LION, settled three wide towards the rear, came under a ride angled five wide for home and made no impact. PLEIADIAN saved ground in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, faded and tired in the drive.
