Footnotes

MOUNTAIN TOP showed good speed while between rivals, dug in gamely when set down for the drive and was clear under the wire. LION HEARTED, close up inside in hand, found a clear path on the rail in the stretch but was outfinished in the final furlong. SENSE OF DUTY raced with the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. EXILED GROOM chased the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. DYNAMITE FLASH contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. HECTOR raced between rivals and offered nothing. INSIYABI, outrun early, put in a wide run on the turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive.
