AMARELLE raced with the pace while between rivals, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. LADY LIBERTY was unprepared for the start, was away in a tangle, rallied wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. E. B.'S SWEEP raced with the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. AMADA was bumped at the start, was outrun early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. TREASURE BEACH contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. CALYPSO STAR was bumped at the start, raced inside and tired.
