COSMONAUT raced in hand early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. CARTAGE AGENT was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. TIVERTON raced close up early, put in a three wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. THUNDER ANEES contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. AROUND VIEW contested the pace along the inside and tired. AMBASSADOR DAN was outrun. R. C. INDY trailed throughout. REBELRY broke down and was vanned off.
