### Footnotes

ANY GIVEN SATURDAY came away well, raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, bumped with SIGHTSEEING on the backstretch, took over from BELIEVEINMENOW after the opening three quarters, drew clear from NOBIZ LIKE SHOBIZ when roused in upper stretch and widened under a drive. NOBIZ LIKE SHOBIZ raced close up outside, advanced three wide approaching the stretch and finished well to be second best. SIGHTSEEING raced close up along the inside, bumped with the winner on the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, angled out into the stretch and had no rally. BELIEVEINMENOW quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired after the opening three quarters. HELSINKI dropped back early, raced inside and was never in contention.
