ADMIRAL BIRD was rated in the middle of the pack between horses, lodged a rally four wide on the turn, made a run to challenge in upper stretch, surged to the front in midstretch, lugged in under right hand urging causing crowding in deep stretch and prevailed under brisk urging. MY MAN LARS dropped back soon after the start, was outrun for a half, swung six wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. BETHPAGE BLACK steadied and was bumped along the backstretch, advanced between horses while five wide entering the stretch and finished well but could not get up. DOC N ROLL saved ground after breaking slowly, raced in traffic between horses on the turn, lodged a bid between horses in upper stretch, checked in tight in midstretch, battled into deep stretch and steadied sharply inside ADMIRAL BIRD in the late stages. TYPHOON TYCOON pressed the pace from outside for a half, made a run to challenged in upper stretch was brushed while dueling along the inside in deep stretch and weakened late. GOOD PROSPECT was unhurried for a half while saving ground, lacked room while boxed in on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, steadied in traffic nearing the furlong

marker then failed to menace while moving out inside the furlong marker. SOLID STRIKE steadied after breaking slowly, was hustled up along the rail, dueled on the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way in midstretch. CHIEF TASHMO dropped far back soon after the start and was never a factor while eight wide at the quarter pole. QUANTUM MERIT was bumped between horses along the backstretch, steadied in traffic at the half mile pole, was shuffled back while lacking room on the far turn and was never close thereafter. VICTORIOUS AFFAIR stalked four wide for six furlongs, steadied in upper stretch and gave way. THUNDER MINISTER steadied in tight along the backstretch, steadied along the rail while lacking room on the turn and was never close thereafter. Following a stewards inquiry as well as a claim of foul by the rider of DOC N ROLL, ADMIRAL BIRD was disqualified from first and placed fourth for interference in the stretch
