Footnotes

DANTASTIC broke in the air at the start, raced well back, was behind a wall of horses on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and closed strongly to get up in the final strides. STORMY SUCCESS raced between horses for a half, swung four wide for room on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, led into deep stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. MINNIE PUNT pressed the pace under a firm hold for five furlongs, battled heads apart into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. URBAN FLIGHT pressed the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. ADMIRAL BIRD steadied in traffic on the backstretch, raced just off the pace between horses for seven furlongs and lacked a late response. ZIP TO THE CITY raced within striking distance five wide to the turn and lacked a late closing response. SOLVENT saved ground in good position for six furlongs and lacked a rally. GRASBERG raced up close along the rail for six furlongs and faltered. RODEO HAND in hand early, never reached contention. OLYMPIC PEGASUS was used up dueling along the rail.
