REDEEMED three wide, contently stalked the pacesetter for nearly a half, moved up when ready to confront that opponent as the pair neared the five-sixteenths pole, remained abreast of a more energetically-handled foe for the remainder of the run around the bend, was asked for to pick it up as the stretch duel commenced, battled on nearly even terms during the ensuing furlong, took over shortly afterwards and kicked clear under a vigorous hand ride. BOJAN got off awkwardly, but assumed control nonetheless, was rated in the two path while carving the pace, was asked for some run when joined by the top one late on the turn, entered the stretch under much stronger urging, successfully held off the eventual winner during the opening portion of the stretch drive, succumbed to that one's relentless pressure soon after leaving the furlong grounds, and had to settle for being second best. LAW ENFORCEMENT saved ground throughout, was driven into the stretch, proved no match for the top twosome. ENDLESS CIRCLE chased outside and tired. CRISTIANO (PER) bobbled at the break, raced three wide, failed to reach a contending position.
