Footnotes

SHOW TRIAL stacked five wide leaving the backstretch, stayed within good striking distance taking the overland route around the bend, got called upon approaching the quarter pole, went down the lane in a spirited tussle latched just to the outside of GENTLE EDWIN, began to inch away departing the furlong grounds, then dug in stubbornly to preserve the decision, crossing the finish line under hand encouragement. GENTLE EDWIN underwent a four wide pursuit, was asked for a response late on the turn, wrestled away the advantage from a weakening SCIBELLI to lead a tightly-grouped field into the stretch, hooked up a stretch duel with the top one after settling in upper stretch, battled hard and on nearly even terms the entire length of the lane, began to lose contact in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but dug in stubbornly to preserve the place. SHERAGUSKA placed in the four path in preparation for the stretch run, was forced to await options, stuck behind rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, was given his cue after gaining some running run spinning into the stretch, ducked over to the inside for optimal racing clearance near the three-sixteenths pole, had a good rail rally to secure the show. GREEN BANANAS devoid of early foot, fanned six wide into the stretch and rallied past weak and tired ones en route for the last major slice of the pot. MERLIN BAY saved ground throughout. FRENCH TRANSITION had no rally. FEROCIOUS WON stalked the front runner for six furlongs before backing away. EX PAT forwardly placed while off the inside, was through after completing three-quarters. SCIBELLI urged to the front, held a loose early lead, felt heavy pressure coming to the five-sixteenths pole, and despite being put to encouragement, soon succumbed to it.
