MEDIEVAL SWORD underwent a three wide journey, stayed within range under light encouragement from midpoint on the far turn, turned for home in the four path and was immediately set down, gained ground readily as he made through the furlong grounds, drew on even terms with runner up a short distance from the sixteenth pole, kept up the fight and got his nose down in time at the wire to earn the decision. ATITLAN well placed along the outside, sat on hold for until the head of the stretch, commenced to rally in earnest three wide at the top of the lane, wore down MIGHTYLOVER to take over, a few strides into the final furlong, had no sooner grabbed the front when confronted by the top one, dug in gamely, but got denied. MIGHTYLOVER rated contesting the pace until the quarter pole, took over at the quarter pole, edged away during the next eighth, but with several rivals still in hot pursuit, yielded to the runner up a few strides prior to the sixteenth pole, but held well for the show. FREUD'S DEBUT three wide around both turns, finished willingly. DOUBLESPEAK contently tracked the front runners while sitting a pocket trip, maneuvered around a tiring rival turning for home, had sufficient clearance for the stretch drive, lacked the needed response. NEWMAN ROCKS had a three to four wide trip, was no factor. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE saved ground and had no kick. MAZARA DEL VALLO vied for the lead along the outside and was through after completing three-quarters. FIND THE STASH was steadied after being rank early, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. DUNWOODY angled three wide into the lane, failed to menace.
