Footnotes

PRIVATE COUNCEL broke near the top but was allowed to drop back in the initial stages, moved up towards the front runners from the three path on the turn, had no trouble overhauling a tiring JOY RISING in upper stretch to take over, drew well clear of the others, finishing in the late stages under a brisk hand ride. PIQUE OUT was turned sideways after bumping with JOY RISING at the start, settled near the front, chased the pacesetter from the two path, ducked over to the rail approaching the quarter pole after closing in fast on the leader's heels, lost contact with the winner down the lane but held on well for the place. CANDELABRA was taken hold after being bumped soon after the start, sat in midpack, left the three-eighths pole four wide, turned for home but lacked the needed response. SHEILA'S GOLD the early leader, yielded coming to the end of the backstretch, was through after going three-quarters despite put to a drive from the midway point on the turn. LA BUSTA swung five wide into upper stretch, failed to be a factor. BLAZING ARCHES saved ground to no avail. JOY RISING made solid contact with PIQUE OUT leaving the starting gate, stumbled after bouncing off that opponent then went to bump hard with CANDELABRA, moved up to secure a forward post, sat under a snug hold but refused to rate kindly, was given some rein and went by the early pacesetter, was asked for run early on the turn, got set down just past the midway point on the turn, began to shorten abruptly coming to the quarter pole squandering what was once a comfortable advantage, faded badly during the stretch drive. CHUBBALITA'S JOY was never in the hunt. THAT'S THE MOVE trailed throughout, was pulled up quickly after crossing the finish line.
