ALL IN BLUE took up the chase on PATENT from the three path on the turn, gained command midpoint on the bend and drew out to a healthy margin during the rest of the way around it, lengthened away, proceeding down the lane primarily under a brisk hand drive. WE MISS ARTIE checked getting put in tight quarters between rivals at the nine-sixteenths pole, got going back on stride and was sent over to the rail a furlong later, angled back to the outside heading for the top of the lane, proved no match for the winner while well clear of the others for the place award. SLEW'S BREW took the inside route on the turn, tipped slightly wider for the stretch and rallied for the show. MISCHIEVOUS ONE three wide entering the stretch, was five wide exiting it, drifted outward even more while tiring. SOUPER LUCKY hustled by the pilot upon being sprung from the starting gate, checked when placed in tight along the rail as PATENT was angling in sharply at that juncture, checked again in close proximity off heels as WE MISS ARTIE was tucking along the rail a furlong down the road, was taken outward, swung four wide into the stretch, had no response. PATENT broke outward as the field was sent on its way, was grabbed hold and angled inward sharply right afterwards, put a pair in tight quarters shortly before reaching the end of the backstretch, vied to hold on to the lead from the two path, yielded to the winner at the three-eighths pole and steadily tired. SMOOTH DADDY taken hold while reaching out greenly making his way towards the half mile pole, remained under that hold while continuing to race greenly for about an additional eighth, commenced the stretch three wide, had no offering.
