TAP THE ADMIRAL raced close up while in hand, took over when asked for run, drew clear when roused and remained safely clear under a drive. LEFT ON NELSON was rated outside, raced three wide and rallied outside to get the place. BOASTFUL chased outside and weakened in the final furlong. LETRADO (ARG) raced inside and had no rally. SEATTLE MAILMAN tired after an inside trip. SMITHSON VALLEY broke slowly and had no rally. IPSYPIPSY had no response when roused. PROMISING PROSPECT was hustled to the front and tired after three quarters.
