Footnotes

MINESHAFT showed good speed and raced with the pace while well in hand, cruised to the front on the second turn, turned back a bid from VOLPONI at the top of the stretch, drew clear when shaken up nearing the eighth pole and was ridden out to the wire. VOLPONI raced close up along the inside, advanced on the second turn, angled out, rallied three wide, tried the winner turning for home, could not get by that rival and stayed on gamely to be clearly best of the others. DOLLAR BILL was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. PUZZLEMENT was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and tired in the stretch. EVENING ATTIRE was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. NOTHING FLAT dropped back early, raced outside and had no rally. HERO'S TRIBUTE raced with the pace while three wide and came up empty when asked. JUDGE'S CASE quickly showed in front, set the pace for three quarters and tired.
