WONDER AGAIN raced close up along the inside while in hand, came wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused, drew away and was kept to the task to the wire. STAY FOREVER was rated along inside, angled out for the drive, dug in gamely while being brushed by SPICE ISLAND in the stretch and stayed on to earn the place award. SPICE ISLAND was rated along outside, rallied three wide, came in in the stretch, brushing STAY FOREVER then was outfinished for the place. HUMAITA (GER) was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. BINYA (GER) quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ALCHEMIST was outrun early and had no response when roused. POTRA FABULOUS (ARG) raced with the pace from the outside and tired after the opening three quarters. A claim of foul against the second place finisher by the rider of the third place finisher, alleging interference in the stretch, was dismissed.
