OVEREXTENDED trailed during the early stages of the event while taking the inside route, swung outward after entering the stretch, commenced his rally when given his cue, still had much to do by midstretch, but maintaining his momentum was along in time to go past a weakening leader just before the finish line. BENNY THE WAITER vied for the lead while racing off the inside, took charge after entering the stretch, left the eighth pole with a seemingly insurmountable lead, began weakening with seventy yards to go and was nailed by the top one just before the end. WOLFSON within striking distance along the rail, was angled out after entering the lane, then drifted outward in deep stretch under left handed whipping during the late stages. DR. W contested the pace outside BENNY THE WAITER, was bothered and carried out a bit when WOLFSON came out in deep stretch. EXPRESS TO THEWEST was no factor. PRINCE DUBAI never reached contention. GRAND TREASURE tired after going a half. COMMISSIONER CHRIS was never in the hunt. STYLISH TIGER a forward factor for a half, wilted. SEE MORE SPIRIT was no threat.
