### Footnotes

DOCTOR CHIT lightly urged to the front, set the pace from just off the inside in the two path, was accompanied through the turn by a pair continuing under light urging as the pressure intensified heading to the quarter pole, got let out at that station and edged clear under a drive to prevail. SPORTSWRITER away alertly, was allowed to settle into his own rhythm, raced towards the rear just off the inside, came under urging to pick up the pace nearing the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane, proved unable to reel in the top one while kicking on willingly for the place. SAINT OF SAINTS three wide in close range of the front while under a light hold, was let out at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, kicked on readily but was outfinished for the place and safe for show honors. VEXOR bumped at the start, came under hustling from the rear, swung five wide for home, was out kicked through the lane. HANNIBAL LECTER pressed the pace from the two path while between rivals, was ridden along from the three-eighths pole and weakened in the lane. HE CAN RUN broke in at the start bumping VEXOR before being corrected, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, saved ground throughout and tired.
