QUANTITY reserved towards the rear in the two path, got enough clearance to slip out steadily midway on the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home fully engaged by the rider, collared the front at he furlong marker and inched away under a drive to the wire. CITIZEN WELLS saved ground towards the rear, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, swung three wide for home, angled out for a clear lane one path with a furlong remaining, kicked home belatedly with good energy to just garner the place honors on the line. WILDCATTER well rated and patiently handled just in behind the pace, awaited an opening at the quarter pole and was let out swinging three wide for home, matched strides with the top one briefly in and around the furlong marker, continued on with good kick to the wire but was outfinished for the place in the last jump while clear for show honors. DODGING reserved at the rear while just off the inside, swung four wide for home under a drive, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. ROMANCING THE GOLD under a firm hold early on while just off the pace, raced four wide throughout, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole and was out kicked through the lane. RUNAWAY JIM vied early on in the two path, was let out at the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. KIPPERS N' EGGS well rated three wide in close range attending the vying duo, got spirited up spinning from the two path into the lane and offered no response. LT. JOHN vied inside for three-quarters and faltered. ANNAWON raced in the overland route throughout and tired.
