Footnotes

CARRIED INTEREST was hustled away from the gate to secure a forward position, sparred with SAYAAD while racing the outside, under much milder hand urging than before, edged away from his nemesis late on the turn, as three rivals were gearing up for the stretch run, responded positively when given his cue at the top of the lane, arrived at the eighth pole with the runner up latched on, dug in with good determination, kept busy to the end. PALACE MALICE quickly tucked along the rail after the start, sat well placed from there keeping pace with an embattled pair, angled outward and squeezed his way into the three path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, remained wedged between rivals for the remainder of the way around the bend, bumped lightly with TRANSLATION spinning into the lane, got hitched up to the top one soon afterwards, closed in gradually during the last eighth but had to settle for being second best. HORSEPOWER took the overland route around the turn, was forced to take the five path for entrance into the stretch once the runner up was maneuvered outward, proved no match for the top pair. COOLUSIVE off the inside, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied mildly to improve position. TRANSLATION sat perched three wide off the early pace dispute, lost position to the second place finisher late on the turn, bumped lightly with that rival entering the stretch, altered course inward after the incident and tired. ZACCHEUS took the inside route, angled outward at the quarter pole, came up empty. SAYAAD argued for command from the inside until near the quarter pole before backing away. BOSS MAN ROCKET was steadied after breaking outward, failed to reach contention.
