Footnotes

RIVER DANCER away last from the gate, was allowed to settle into stride, was tipped into the three path coming to the midway point on the turn, went onward for another sixteenth and after being let out at notch picked up interest, fanned widest of all, full of run, into the stretch, eventually being at least eight wide by the three-sixteenths pole, closed in with good energy after getting straightened away, rolled by the runner up in the final seventy yards and edged away, switched over to confident handling for the last couple of jumps. MARVIN'S MIRACLE took up the chase three wide, crept up into a good striking position from the five-sixteenths marker, was the widest of three heads apart with each other leading the others into the stretch, gained a slim lead once past the furlong grounds, got reeled in by the top one, held on in willing manner for the place. BANDIT BOB reserved in the two path for nearly a half, swung into action coming to the quarter pole, fanned outward to be about six wide halfway through the furlong grounds, flattened out late. MOM'S QUALITY bumped lightly with SPUN at the start, was placed into the two path shortly after AINTEASYBEINGGREEN was sent over to the inside route, prompted that opponent until the later stages of the run around the bend, increased his presence and challenged from between foes heading for the stretch, arrived first at the eighth pole, albeit by the slimmest of margins and with a host of others in hot pursuit, soon yielded and steadily weakened. JOHN BAILEY shied outward several steps from the rival breaking next door, was guided towards the rail and sneaked his way into the pocket in the vicinity of the half mile pole, tracked the front runners from there, waited briefly in traffic at the end of the bend, tipped to be two wide for the commencement of the stretch, had another drift into the same path almost immediately afterwards and altered course back to the rail, was called upon and lacked a solid closing response. AINTEASYBEINGGREEN angled in sharply after the start and got placed along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, cut the pace being rated and with MOM'S QUALITY keeping watch just off her hind quarters, had that rival and the second place finisher pounce upon her approaching the quarter pole, got asked for run in response to the stiff challenge, yielded to each of them and steadily tired in the final furlong. SPUN lightly bumped at the start, raced along the outside, was given his cue and angled four wide into the stretch, made no headway.
