BEDOUIN NOW saved ground on the opening bend, ventured into the two path for a while proceeding down the backstretch but was back along the inside by the half mile pole, vacated the premises coming to the five-sixteenths marker, angled outward three wide in preparation for the stretch drive, was kept on hold for a couple of jumps and then after gaining optimal racing clearance was given his cue, closed in relentlessly on the game runner up, finally nailing that opponent with about two jumps to go. PRUDENT INVESTOR grabbed the early advantage and was guided over to the rail, had ARTIE'S JASPER make it a three-way scramble for command nearing the half mile pole, argued to maintain the lead being pressed by that pair parked to the outside almost all of the way around the turn, reached the top of the lane and was called upon, gamely clung to a narrow advantage before getting caught in the very late stages. FLOWING MANE in the three path, disputed the pair as the widest of a trio for a quarter starting from top of the turn, held on with good courage to the end to secure the show. SAVED THE BEST swung five into the stretch and mustered up a mild response to take the last major check. GALACTICO sat within range from off the inside, was already under encouragement taking the four path into the stretch, made no gain. ARTIE'S JASPER patiently handled racing from off the rail during the opening stages, squeezed his way into the two path coming to the end of the backstretch, fought for the lead from between rivals to near the quarter pole, gave way.
