MALIBU HOLIDAY off the inside, picked up the pace after completing the opening half, spun four wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after the front runners after settling into upper lane, charged down the center of the course to grab away the lead in deep stretch and edge away. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER travelled four wide on the turn, entered the stretch and got called upon, kicked into her best stride and closed in on the leader, battled for command from between opponents from the sixteenth pole to the final seventy yards, never did grab the front, but continued on with good courage to procure the place. STRATEGIC MISSILE sat patiently perched three wide on the turn, neared the stretch and got asked for her best, arrived at the eighth pole with only a narrow deficit left to make up, fought with vigor from between rivals in the late stages while earning the show award. TIZ TERESA vied for command from the two path, took over the lead soon after departing the backstretch, achieving the top without need of encouragement, reached the head of the stretch still in the clear and was asked for a response, gave it, yielded reluctantly well past the sixteenth pole. YES IT'S PINK along the rail down the backstretch, remained from off it thereafter, swung five wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. READY SIGNAL tracked the frontrunners while loosely pocketed down the backstretch and a bit beyond, vacated that spot and was tipped into the two path once UNABASHED had been displaced on the lead, this occurring in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, bided time between rivals while proceeding towards the end of the bend, had the leader drift outward slightly turning for home and altered course back to the rail, had what little room there was to begin with to launch a rally get clamped down almost immediately afterwards, remained stuck behind TIZ TERESA until nearing the sixteenth pole, altered course back into the two path at that station, had another rival drift into it a few strides later, completed the race drafting behind a slew of rivals. UNABASHED disputed the pace from the rail, relinquished without much fight near the seven-sixteenths pole and faltered.
