Footnotes

ALL ALEX just off the inside towards the rear initially, got set down swinging four wide for home, angled out two paths straightened away for a clear lane, offered up a good kick arriving on the scene in the final sixteenth and just got up on the wire to win the bob. DENDRITE two to three wide in mid pack, got let out swinging five wide into upper stretch, dug in with good energy into contention a furlong out, took command in the final seventy yards under threat from the aforementioned rival, led nearest the finish and was nailed on the wire. BALLYBRIT just off the pace just off the inside, got set down at the five-sixteenths, rallied to the furlong grounds the main danger a furlong out, took brief command a sixteenth from home, was displaced by a pair while fighting on to the wire in the last seventy yards and forced to settle for the show honors. SAGUARO BLOSSOM vied from just off the inside with POWDER SPRINGS while well rated, got let out spinning three wide into the stretch, dug in under challenge by a host of pursuers a furlong out, got headed a sixteenth from home and kept on well for the last major share. BROTHER BRENDAN hesitated at the start then broke a bit awkward conceding four or five lengths to the front, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under prolonged urging from the seven-sixteenths, advanced mildly into range nearing the quarter pole, angled three wide at that station, rallied with a mild kick through the stretch while unable to make an impact. RIDE A SONG squeezed lightly at the start when POWDER SPRINGS broke inwards, attended the arguing pair up front three wide within aim, got set down swinging four wide into the stretch, fought on to the eighth pole before weakening through the final furlong. ITS WHAT I DO saved ground in mid pack ridden along from the five-sixteenths and offered no response. KING WANDO broke a bit awkwardly at the start, settled three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. POWDER SPRINGS broke in at the start bumping and squeezing back RIDE A SONG lightly, was

forwardly placed to vie inside of SAGUARO BLOSSOM, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, kept on mildly to the eighth pole before giving way in the final furlong.
