STRONG HOPE showed good speed along the inside, took charge after leaving the chute, set the pace, drew clear, responded when roused, dug in gamely on the rail and held off NACHEEZMO under a drive. NACHEEZMO was outrun early on, advanced inside on the turn, angled out for the drive and was coming fast from the outside at the finish. SKY MESA showed good speed while in hand, chased the winner from the outside and stayed on gamely in the stretch. PRIVATE CITY was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. BEST MINISTER was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. GO ROCKIN' ROBIN had no response when roused. ALBAAZ chased the pace while three wide and tired after the opening three quarters.
