### Footnotes

ALVITO contently brought up the back of the pack in the early going, picked up interest late on the turn and fanned five wide, the widest of all, into upper stretch, gained ground readily on the front runners, closed in tandem with the runner up leaving the eighth pole, with each rival being given left handed stick work and drifting outward, kicked clear of ACADIAN BLUES in the final seventy yards under confident handling. ACADIAN BLUES settled into midpack after the start, was coaxed along from the two path while keeping pace with the front runners, came four wide into the stretch, closed in on the new leader, while drifting outward in response to a left handed whip, continued to drift towards the grandstand apron while still under the left whip leaving the eighth pole, went by the show horse simultaneously with the winner, failed to keep pace with that opponent after having done and had to settle for the place. DECESION POINT underwent a three wide pursuit, was under encouragement making a challenge for command coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took over and led the field into the stretch, extended the margin during the next furlong, got overhauled by the top twosome in deep stretch. EYE WITNESS tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, tired. GIANT INDIAN broke slowly and went on to save ground to no avail. HEAVY DUTY was put to strong urging to secure a forward position, pressed the issue from the outside for the opening half, moved up to challenge in earnest from between foes at the five-sixteenths pole, tired after entering the stretch. GALLANT EAGLE (IRE) raced along the outside and was outrun. ROBERT'S BREACH established control soon after the start, showed the way from the rail, with the rider giving some encouragement to the mount, came under pressure from the two closest pursuers leaving the midway point on the turn, offered brief resistance to the stern test before yielding, retreated steadily thereafter.
