FIDDLERS AFLEET tracked the sprinted speed duel while taking the inside route, was let out a notch midway on the turn and picked up real estate readily on the embattled pair up front, got set down a few strides past the five-sixteenths pole and angled sharply three wide for the stretch run, with dead aim on the pace survivor, overhauled that opponent, who by now was starting to show some effects from his earlier efforts, drew off decisively departing the furlong grounds, doing so under a hard drive. UNCLE T SEVEN bumped from both sides, was taken hold and squeezed back at the start, left the backstretch from the three path and gave chase from there for most of the way around the turn, put to some light urging while doing so, spun five wide, the widest of all into the stretch, got straightened away, wasn't unable to keep pace with the winner proceeding towards the finish line, held on well though to secure second. BE BULLISH got bumped at the start, was the middle member of the second flight chasing a hot pace, got put to a prolonged drive, spun from the four path and from between opponents into upper stretch, flattened out. MINE OVER MATTER commenced an intensified pace fight with DRIVEN BY SUCCESS leaving the starting gate, put up his fight from along the inside, under urging, as was his fellow combatant, shook free coming to the quarter pole, gaining a respite, came under assault during the initial portion of the stretch drive, yielding without much resistance and backed away. LAW ENFORCEMENT loped along for the opening half, drifted four wide into upper stretch and further still by the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. BAMBIBOUND was bumped at the start, tucked along the inside in plenty of time for the run around the bend, was taken outward and gradually swung into the four path by the three-sixteenths pole, came up empty. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS angled inward sharply leaving the starting gate and got engaged in a lively tussle with MINE OVER MATTER, sparred on nearly even terms with that rival from two path, with both battlers being asked for some run by their pilots, fell back despite feeling the whip past the five-sixteenths pole and steadily retreated.
