TOUCHOFSTARQUALITY broke about two jumps behind the penultimate breaker after making sustained contact with the left side of the starting gate and getting turned slightly sideways, was guided over to the rail midway down the backstretch, remained unhurried and along the inside route until shortly before reaching the quarter pole, picked up interest and proceeded to get taken outward, winding up in the five path at the head of the stretch, was asked for a response and gave it without hesitation, arrived at the eighth pole full of momentum and closing in rapidly on the runner up, drew on even terms in the final seventy yards, went by under confident handling. SLIVER AND ONIONS moved up into a more prominent position nearing the end of the backstretch, departed it from the three path and contested the pace as the widest of a threesome to the five-sixteenths marker, had the inside member of the tussle call it a day at that point and was guided over closer to the rail, spun into the stretch with a clear advantage and got set down, got collared in the final seventy yards and had to settle for being second best. LOCHTE forwardly placed right from the get-go, contested the pace from between rivals from the top of the turn until the five-sixteenths pole, got shaken off by the runner up soon afterwards, entered the stretch and proved no match for the top twosome. SUPREME COMMANDER sluggish after the start, partnered up with the top one for nearly six furlongs while racing along the outside, fanned six wide (the widest of all) into the stretch, rallied mildly to mainly improve position. REGIMENT gave chase from near the two path, was under a drive entering the stretch, came up empty. TAKAJAO raced from between opponents for most of the way around the turn, took the three path for entrance into the stretch, tired. EASEMENT three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, had no response. LET THE CAT OUT got away slightly tardily after ducking inward at the start, raced along the inside, argued with another pair parked to the outside from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths marker, faltered.
