Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2002 allowed 2 lbs. \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2002; or \$40,000 twice in 2002, 4 lbs.; \$50,000; or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over, 6 lbs. \$30,000, or three races other than maiden or claiming, 8 lbs. (Maiden, restricted and restricted stake races not considered in allowances.) Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, June 22, 2002 with 27 Nominations.

GYGISTAR broke running, dictated the pace while in hand, turned back a bid from YANKEE GENTLEMAN on the turn, opened a sizeable advantage when roused then dug in gamely along the inside and held on under a drive. NOTHING FLAT was outrun early, rallied three wide and finished gamely while drifting out through the stretch. AMERICAN STYLE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. MY MAN RYAN was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. YANKEE GENTLEMAN hit the gate at the start, ducked in after the start, raced close up early inside, took a run at the winner on the turn, could not get by that rival and tired in the stretch. HEIR D' TWINE dropped back early and had no response when roused.
