FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Nominees only. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded revert to the Fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000; or \$45,000 in 2007, 4 lbs.; \$30,000, or two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, restricted and restricted stake races not considered in allowances.) Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, June 23, 2007 with 20 Nominations.

DREAM RUSH showed good speed from the start, contested the pace from the outside, drew clear on the turn, widened when roused in upper stretch and was kept to the task to the finish. GRAEME SIX was outrun early, advanced four wide on the turn, responded when roused and finished gamely outside. SILVER KNOCKERS was hustled along inside, came wide entering the stretch and finished well outside. TICKET TO SEATTLE was hustled from the gate, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. CASH'S GIRL was hustled along inside, chased the pace and had no response when roused. APPEALING ZOPHIE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. HALF TIME CROWN leapt in the air at the start, raced four wide throughout and tired. MAGICAL RIDE raced between rivals and finished early. HER MAJESTY stumbled at the start, raced wide and tired.
