FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to enter, starters to receive a \$750 rebate. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. The Purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three Year Olds 118, Older 123.

Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf since January 1, allowed 2 lbs. Three Races, 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances) Starters to be named at closing time of entries. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Thursday June 30, 2011 with 21 nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Sixteenth on the main track.)

Footnotes

BEAU CHOIX contently tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, turned for home, appearing eager to swing outward, but lacking the opportunity, momentarily angled outward nearing the eighth pole in preparation to try and split rivals but stutter stepped his way back inward once the rail appeared to be the more promising choice to make, edged away to a clear advantage with a sixteenth to go, then dug in gamely to fend off POCKET COWBOY for the decision. POCKET COWBOYS underwent a three wide journey, bid in earnest as the field headed for the top of the stretch, finished gamely but missed. BOOTS AHEAD between rivals for a good portion of the running, was under encouragement challenging for the lead coming to the quarter pole, continued onward stubbornly down the length of the lane, but had to settle for show honors. STORMY'S MAJESTY rated inside until the quarter pole, came under heavy pressure at that juncture of the event, offered good resistance during the ensuing furlong, weakened a bit thereafter. VOODOO SWINGE off a beat slowly, lagged at the back of the pack until the quarter pole while taking the inside route, was forced to idle within striking distance from the top of the stretch until the sixteenth pole, never venturing more than a path off the inside throughout the stretch drive, finally gained clear racing room towards the rail, but too late to seriously menace. SANGAREE lacked the needed response. UNCLE T SEVEN three wide around each bend, tired.
