PAGE BY PAGE chased the leader for nearly a half, was put to some rousing while issuing a challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, went down the lane engaged in a spirited tussle with PAPER PLANE, shook that one off in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away under good handling. PAPER PLANE established command before reaching the turn was rated on a loosely contested lead while positioned slightly off the inside, was let out in response to pressure coming from the top one a few strides into the stretch run, gave up the front when no longer able to keep pace a short distance from the sixteenth marker, but finished with good energy to be well clear of the others for place honors. SENORA DUBAI raced along the inside, appeared uncomfortable and was steadied twice as she made her way from midpoint on the backstretch to the half mile pole, kept within range during the run around the bend, proved no match for the top twosome. CITY SCAMPER placed in the four path midway on the turn, folded. PROUD DAME three wide departing the backstretch, ducked over to the rail at the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the stretch under encouragement, came up empty. CORI'S MINT JULEP bumped soundly at the start with MOJITO MINT, was urged early but failed to rejoin the group. MOJITO MINT was bumped hard after stumbling badly at the start, trailed thereafter.
