COUNT CATAMOUNT settled into midpack after the start, rated kindly from the two path under a good hold from the rider, waited for suitable options behind rivals heading for the quarter pole, remained on hold for an additional sixteenth, moved slightly towards the inside and got unleashed, overhauled the runner

up leaving the furlong grounds and edged away. SAINTS ALIVE contested the pace from the two path, shook off the fellow pace combatant late on the turn before being given his cue, arrived at the eighth pole still holding a slight lead, but with the eventual winner having made his presence felt, relinquished soon afterwards, then dug in long enough to salvage second. SIX FLINGS unhurried along the outside for nearly a half, fanned six wide into the stretch, displayed good energy down the outside the course, missed out on gaining place honors. RECHARGED saved ground on the turn, vacated the premises during the initial portion of the stretch run, mustered up a mild response to take the final major slice of the pot. GALAXY KAT tracked the front runners while sitting in the pocket, slipped to be two wide just prior to the quarter pole and got called upon, flattened out. FISHERMAN'S WHARF raced along the outside, took the three path for entrance into the stretch, failed to make an impact. TOQUE pressed a pair of rivals from the three path until the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor for another eighth before weakening. SLY cut the corner into the stretch, was taken outward shortly afterwards, went on to improve position. CORONATION DAY chased three wide and tired. TIGER WILLIE placed seven wide at the head of the stretch, was no threat. EZZY vied for command from the rail for a half and gave way. EXTRA ZIP made light contact with COUNT CATAMOUNT at the start, was three wide and asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, failed to give any and tired.
