THE MIXER allowed to settle early on while well rated, raced three to four wide through the turn towards the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, surged into prominence with an eighth to go, drifted out through the final furlong shying from near sided stick work while displaying a good kick down the center of the course to displace the front in the last strides and prevail. ZAJAL under reserve in midpack down along the rail, availed of the opportunity to slip out one path at the three-eighths pole and commence a bid on the front, took command at the top of the lane roused while three wide, edged away to a good advantage with an eighth to go, kicked home with good energy leading until the final strides when caught and forced to settle for the place. BACK ROOM DEAL two to three wide towards the rear, got set down at the top of the lane swinging four wide, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. WIN FOR THE ZIPPER tracked the pace inside, cut the corner placed to a drive, ended up stalled in behind the tiring pace setter and off the near side of another foe awaiting an opening until nearing the sixteenth marker, finally had a seam develop and went on through albeit mildly late on for the last major share. WICKED IRISH loosely handled prompting the pace from the two path, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the lane. MATT AND JESSE in close pursuit initially from the three path, remained unhurried losing position while two to three wide in the turn, got asked at the

quarter pole spinning four wide, made no late headway. NO MORE TAXES forwardly placed, was pushed along while four wide through the turn from the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch and tired. FULLCONTROL set the pace inside lightly prompted, cut the corner roused into the lane, was displaced on the front straightening away, faltered in the final eighth. RUDYARD REWARD crossed to the rail after the start, was pushed along from towards the rear saving ground throughout and made no impact. NORTHERN HERO off a beat slow, was hustled from the get go and trailed throughout.
