Footnotes

TOTHEENDOFTHEEARTH (IRE) tracked the pace inside well rated until nearing the head of the lane, shifted out to the three path at that station commencing a drive, displayed a good kick down the lane to just get up in the final jumps and prevail among a host in contention late on. ISLAND SCHOOL on the pace inside lightly prompted and given a little rein to work with, remained on that scenario until set down cutting the corner into the lane, got headed with a furlong remaining, fought back on to reestablish the front then was caught in the last strides in a blanket finish while holding well to the end to procure the place. FIRE ASSAY three deep towards the rear, was let out swinging one additional path inside at the top of the lane, angled out in the vicinity of the eighth pole for a clear lane, kicked home with good energy belatedly down the center to garner the show on the line. TOWN FLIRT coaxed along from towards the back while three wide in the turn at the three-eighths pole, made steady progress on the front, spun four wide to five wide in upper stretch, kicked home with good energy through the lane but was outfinished by a trio while garnering the last major share. DREAMING OF CARA reserved towards the rear while saving ground, was asked at the head of the lane cutting the corner, made two or three attempts to angle out and lacked any room to make the move among a host of rivals charging through the final eighth, lacked a clear lane to rally until the final strides. QUEEN OF KING ST stumbled badly at the start, bumped lightly with THISIZSPARTA as she recovered her footing, attended the pace from the two path, was put to a drive at the head of the lane, seized command briefly by a short margin with an eighth to go, battled through to the wire running on well but was outfinished in the late stages. FORBIDDEN GIFT under reserved towards the rear just off the inside, was let out cutting the corner and made no impact. COLOR BLIND three to four wide in close range of the front, lost position nearing the quarter pole as more energetically handled rivals went by, offered no rally. THISIZSPARTA bumped lightly at the start when QUEEN OF KING ST recovered her footing, sat in close range unhurried from the two path until the three-eighths pole, was asked at that station, swung four wide for home and tired.
