EMMA'S ENCORE away alertly, was allowed to settle just off the inside unhurried chasing from towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, continued in the two path turning for home, moved into prominence angling out two paths for a clear lane at the furlong marker, kicked strongly through the final sixteenth to take command and prevail going away at the end. JAMAICAN SMOKE dueled from the two path, took the lead nearing the three-eighths pole, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, inched away to a safe lead before being engaged at the eighth pole, fought on well through the final furlong, was overhauled in the late stages by the top one, dug in to hold well for place honors. TU ENDIE WEI stumbled at the start, recovered to track the duel from just off the inside, shifted out to the three path just past the three-eighths pole, commenced a bid from the five-sixteenths gaining ground and position on the leader, confronted that rival with an eighth to go in earnest, battled through the lane for command, was overhauled in tandem with her main rival by the eventual winner in the late stages, got repulsed for the place honors as well despite running on readily well clear for the show. SEA ISLAND outrun in the early going, came under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths to close in, swung four wide for home and passed tired rivals through the lane. AGAVE KISS dueled inside through solid fractions, came under light urging at the three-eighths pole before being set down in earnest cutting the corner for home and gave way after straightening away. GYPSY ROBIN three wide in close range of the front, came under a spirited ride at the five-sixteenths and offered no response.
