EFFIE TRINKET lightly prompted the pace two to three wide in hand, got set down at the head of the stretch, took over the front nearing the final furlong, inched away under a drive shying in under off sided stick work late and prevailed driving. BELLA CASTANI settled towards the rear three wide behind cover, came under encouragement angled four wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick for the place honors. FAB FLOWERS tracked the pace along the inside, got roused spinning just off the inside into the stretch, offered up a mild kick to procure the show while unable to make headway in the late stages. MAGNIFICENT SHIRL saved ground towards the rear, got angled and asked five wide into upper stretch, offered up a belated kick for the last major share. FEARLESS JACQ (IRE) cut the pace inside in hand under light prompting from the outside by the eventual winner, cut the corner into upper stretch roused for the drive, got headed nearing the eighth pole then weakened through the final furlong. EXCHANGE CAT just off the pace three wide in reserve until the five-sixteenths, continued three wide into upper stretch, offered no response then weakened to the wire.
