SWEET FERVOR broke open the gate prior to the start, raced with the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner and continued on to best the others. SWAP FLIPAROO broke open the gate prior to the start, dropped back early, raced inside and lacked a rally. SILMARIL was hustled outside, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. NOTHING BUT FUN argued the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch.
