AL KHALI assumed command leaving the opening bend, showed the way, unchallenged and under rating tactics, remained on hold leaving the five-sixteenths pole, despite the urged-along foursome behind narrowing in, was given his cue in upper stretch, spurted away to a sizeable advantage once more and maintained it while being kept under steady encouragement. ROGUE VICTORY unhurried, raced off the inside, was asked for a response upon reaching the second turn, fanned four wide into the stretch, closed well to grab the place. LIME RICKEY sluggish early, moved into a contending position three wide by midpoint on the far turn, lacked the necessary stretch after turning for home. OPERATION RED DAWN mildly pursued the top one for three-quarters before backing off. SUMMER PATRIOT saved ground, was asked for run around the far turn and tired.
