MAUI MARK pressed the issue three wide, with a lane of separation between herself and the leader, drew alongside SCHMOOZ TALKER leaving the half mile pole, raced heads apart with that foe for a while, inched away briefly when confronted by WICKED TUNE making a menacing move on the left flank at the quarter pole, was asked for a response and readily gave it, shook free to arrive at the furlong marker a full body length in front, extended the advantage, kept to a drive until the sixteenth pole. MIDNITE SILVER slow to settle into the stride, picked up the pace from midpoint on the turn taking the inside route, altered course to be the widest of all in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, displayed a good kick to garner the place. FREUDIAN DILEMMA unleashed a three wide run on the turn to reach a good striking position by the head of the stretch, could not sustain the move and had to settle for the show. WICKED TUNE reserved in the two path for nearly a half, was let out a notch and moved to split rivals while launching a bid for command at the end of the turn, bobbed entering the stretch, got rebuffed by the top one during the run through the furlong grounds and outfinished late for an in the money finish. ORSONIAN tracked the front runners while saving ground, angled outward for the stretch run but came up empty. SHMOOZ TALKER argued for control from the inside for a half and gave way.
