DESERT PATROL bobbled at the start but quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace, drew away when asked for run and was kept to the task to the finish. SIR TYLER T was outrun early, raced four wide and rallied to get the place spot. HOW GOOD IS THAT chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. IRISH QUALITY raced greenly along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. JAMOCHA raced greenly inside and tired. ECCLESIASTIC raced between rivals and tired in the stretch. B K'S ON THE PARK raced three wide and tired.
