Footnotes

KITTY NIP settled in good position along the rail, swung five wide to launch her bid at the quarter pole, made a run to challenge in midstretch and edged clear under pressure in the late stages. SKIPPING CLASS pressed the pace from outside for a half, surged to the front nearing the furlong marker then yielded to the winner in the final sixteenth. ODETTA ONE steadied after being pinched back leaving the rail, moved quickly to the rail, raced well back for a half, rallied between horses entering the stretch and closed late to gain a share. BLUEGRASS GIRL settled along the inside to the turn, angled four wide at the top of the stretch and weakened late. CARNIVAL CITY raced in midpack between horses for five furlongs and finished evenly. ADORABLE YOU steadied after breaking inward at the start, was outrun for a half, circled six wide at the quarter pole and failed to menace. SPARKY'S PRECISION checked after being bumped at the start and failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. TOO MUCH ZIP saved ground to the turn, angled between horses, gained a bit in upper stretch and flattened out. SMALL POTATOES steadied early and again between horses at the half mile pole then raced in traffic behind horses in upper stretch. ROMAN QUEEN MARY set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and gave way. ROYAL SKIP trailed throughout after

breaking slowly.
