CENTRINA sat reserved within range while racing along the outside, remained on hold just off the threesome up front as the field turned for home, swung wide, settling into the four path at the head of the stretch, in preparation for the stretch run, responded well once called upon, drew abreast of the leader leaving the furlong grounds, then proved best, nailing that rival in the final jump. EXILED PRINCESS entered the backstretch from the three path, raced within striking distance continuing along that same route for nearly six furlongs, crept up to the front runners under mild urging coming to the quarter pole, fought her way to the front by the time she reached the eighth pole, clung to a narrow edge under strong encouragement, offered stubborn resistance to the end, but was nailed in the last jump. NO RHYME OR REASON tracked the pacesetter from the inside, angled outward at the quarter pole and rallied mildly to grab show honors. SHEHASHIGHOPES was rated stalking the pacesetter from the outside, issued a challenge for command after completing three-quarters, gained the lead at the quarter pole, put up a fight before yielding near the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter. PALACE MISTRESS saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole and never posed a threat. JUDICIAL LEADER cut the pace towards the inside for six furlongs and folded.
