SLIGHT FEVER worked his way to the lead nearing the half mile pole from the two path, opened up a clear advantage in quick fashion, continued to show the way under rating tactics until the three-sixteenths pole, and edged away. SPICY STEVE ducked over to the inside on the turn and finished willingly to grab the place. D'ARGENTO underwent a wide journey, was put to a prolonged drive, but was outfinished. EL GRAN MATADOR raced well off the inside, swung four wide turning for home, lacked a solid kick. ROLLOFTHETUNDRA saved ground and was no factor. BRUSHED OFF three wide, retreated after a half. CENTRIPITAL dragged the rider forward along the rail, wilted after a half.
