STAT gave chase three wide on the turn, was asked for a response from midpoint on the turn, made steady progress on the leader after turning for home, poked a head in front in the vicinity of the eighth pole, kicked clear and held off the late-closing runner up to earn the decision. TRADE was patiently allowed to settle into stride, picked up interest and speed soon after entering the turn, swung into the four path for the stretch drive, charged down the center of the strip, closed the gap from the top one with long strides under intermittent encouragement. STREET FIGHT within range from off the inside, finished willingly en route for the show. ROCKIN BOOGIE assumed a forward position shortly after the start, contested the pace from the two path, remained a forward factor until the eighth pole before weakening. PATRIOTIC LION urged towards the front leaving the starting gate, argued for the lead from the inside, being more energetically handled than his pace rival, was shaken off approaching the five-sixteenths pole and tired. BACKNBIZ placed in the two path for the run around the bend, was coaxed along chasing the ongoing pace dispute, folded after completing a half. DABA DABA three wide departing the backstretch, made a swift move to the inside midway on the turn, rode the rail for a quarter of a mile, swung back to the outside for the stretch run, had little left to offer.
