LOVE STANZA CHANCE tucked into the pocket soon after the start, moved outward to become the main pursuer once AUGUST GALA began to back away, in the vicinity of the half mile pole, stayed latched onto the leader for the run around the far turn, issued a challenge at quarter pole, took over and spurred away from the competition once asked for run in upper stretch and safely maintained the comfortable advantage to the end. TROPICAL JETSET sat reserved in midpack, was let out a notch from the three-eighths pole and cruised up towards the front runners, lurked a danger in the three path turning for home, failed to keep pace with the top one when that opponent was let out, dug in well to preserve the place. MADAME JOHAR left the rail by the end of the backstretch, picked up the pace during the later stages of the run around the far turn, continued on willingly during the stretch drive en route for the show. SILVER MAST off the inside throughout, attempted to reach contention with a four wide run from the three-eighths pole, flattened out. LA BUSTA saved ground until the quarter pole. A NEW YORK PHILLIE between rivals on the far turn, was asked for an response, had no rally. BOUND TO HAPPEN gave chase from the outside down the backstretch, tired. SOINLOVEWITHUAM I forwardly placed off the inside, faltered after completing three-quarters. AUGUST GALA vied for the lead from the inside, faded.
