HONOR GLIDE raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, advanced three wide on the second turn, dug in resolutely in the stretch, came in under a right hand whip in deep stretch, crowding FEDERAL TRIAL over into FAHRIS and causing that rival to take up, then dug in and held off PARADE GROUND for the win. PARADE GROUND, unhurried along the inside, was asked to pick it up nearing the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely from the outside. FEDERAL TRIAL, with the pace while under stout restraint, dug in gamely between rivals in the stretch, was crowded by the winner in deep stretch and stayed on gamely. FAHRIS (IRE) set the pace while in hand, dug in gamely along the rail until forced to take up in deep stretch. CHORWON, outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished with good interest. HEAVENS EAST, outrun early, had no rally. Following a stewards' inquiry and a claim of foul against the third place finisher by the rider of the fourth place finisher, alleging interference in deep stretch; FEDERAL TRIAL was disqualified and placed fourth.
