Footnotes

BARREL OF LOVE was off slowly after bumping soundly with DOUGIE at the break, sat reserved midpack during the run around the bend, fanned four wide into the lane, responded positively once asked for run, closed a solid amount of ground to loom boldly with an eighth to go, then maintaining the momentum, wore down the leader in the late stages to earn the decision. DOUGIE bumped hard with BARREL OF LOVE at the start, raced within range throughout near the inside, was forced to be kept on hold approaching the quarter pole, angled outward after turning for home, lacked optimal racing clearance, altered course back to the rail, was forced to steady when placed in tight by DIRT TRACK DEMON midstretch, got clear in deep stretch and displayed a good late burst of speed to garner place honors. DIRT TRACK DEMON cut the pace towards the inside, and held well to the wire. THE NOZ was steadied slightly after ducking inward at the start, recovered in short order, wound up in the three path, acting greenly, settled down leaving the half mile pole, commenced to rally after being set down in upper stretch, was carried out by a troubled rival in midstretch, being forced to swerve to the outside before bobbling, then finished with a good late kick to grab a major share. MOON RAVEN prompted the pacesetter from the outside and gave way. DON'T CROSS ME threw off the rider prior to the start, proceeded to come out of the gate in good order, chased three wide around the bend, was still in the thick of things when forced to check sharply near the eighth pole to avoid running up the heels of a rival, had no serious offering thereafter. JOE D was never in contention. TINTO leapt at the break, saved ground and tired.
